Lunesdale United Reserves hosted Penrith Rangers Reserves from League Division 2 in the 1<sup>st</sup> round of the Junior Cup at Maurice Park and were not over awed by the two division difference.

The visitors settled quickly and put early pressure on the home defence, but they held out until the 20<sup>th</sup> minute. A quick 1-2 by the visitor's midfield resulted in the 1<sup>st</sup> goal when the visiting forward gave Coward (the home keeper) no chance with a fine shot into the bottom left hand corner. 0-1

The home team came more into the game and good work on both flanks by Alderson & Brewer were dealt with efficiently by Rangers back 4. Mandle in the middle for Lunesdale had several mazy runs, and only strong tackling and good goal keeping kept him out.

Then, in the 45<sup>th</sup> minute a back pass to the visitor's keeper resulted in a free kick to Lunesdale after he controlled the ball then picked it up. Nathan Gill passed square to James Mandle who volleyed in from 6 yards.

The home team started the 2<sup>nd</sup> half well on top, but yet again good defending by Rangers kept the score level.

On 60 minutes, 16 year old Lee Tattersall replaced Brewer on the left and within 5 minutes put the home team ahead when he stole down the left and shot between the keeper and the post.

The game was end to end after this with both teams going all out to score.

On 82 minutes, a good run down Rangers right was crossed and Coward in goal could only parry the cross which dropped to a Rangers forward to tap in. 2-2

Both teams had little opportunity to score again before full time.

**Extra Time:**

The first half of extra time came and went with both defences holding out.

The second half had all the drama and excitement as Rangers took the lead on 20 minutes when a cross from the left found the head of a Rangers forward who made no mistake with a good headed goal. 2-3

Rangers must have thought they had done enough, but Lunesdale's young team had other ideas when 5 minutes later a cross from the right ricocheted off 2/3 players and Tattersall came in from the left and volleyed past the helpless Rangers keeper to square the game once more. 3-3

Rangers went 1<sup>st</sup> and scored, as did Lunesdale until the 4<sup>th</sup> penalty when Gill for the home team missed.

Glen Coward then saved the Rangers 5<sup>th</sup> penalty and Beecham scored for the home team.
